



Admission to Candidacy Ph.D.

Student must also have received approval of the Dissertation Proposal. The student must have been admitted to candidacy at least 1 semester before the degree is conferred.

To apply for admission to candidacy, secure a copy of your graduate transcript from the Registrar's Office and then take it, as well as this form and your degree plan (including any change forms that have been approved for the degree plan), to your major professor. In conference with your major professor, complete the form. The major professor will return the completed form to the Associate Dean (ATCOF) for final approval.
